#### **CLAIMS PROCESS**

- A policy holder will report the claim to Howdie. Assessors are rarely appointed.
- Client will need to supply photos of the road hazard, tyre(s (including make and model) and the damage to the tyre(s). The exact location of the hazard will also need to be recorded. If a tyre(s) is replaced, the tread depth of the damaged tyre(s) must be recorded.



#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- The maximum number of claims payable in a year is limited to two.
- No claim will be indemnified where it occurs within 30 days of the policy inception date.
- All losses, which might result in a claim under this policy, must be reported to the Wheel and Tyre Claims Department or Howdie Claims Department within 30 days of the date of occurrence.
- All damage sustained on gravel roads is excluded from cover.
